Mike Jedziniak, Gaitor Way project: As a Toms River South graduate, attorney in Brielle, a lot of my time is spent in and around South Toms River. I was on the Board of Education for twelve years and I've transitioned to creating this 501 C3 for Alumni, The Gaitor Way initiative. The Gaitor family graduated 10 children. Some went to post high school, teaching, tuskegee airman, pulitzer prize nominated authors. We want to make sure they are honored in a way that is deserving. The paving is the start of the project and monument that we eventually want there. On Wednesday, the Alumni hope to have \$40,000 for the paving via the school board authorization. Earle, Homes For All, and Takama are the three businesses providing the labor and equipment. The project will be started this started. For the second Phase, a new committee will be formed to plan the ceremony, raise additional money, and plan the monument. Today is to inform you all about the timetable, and how we hope to move forward. We want to parlay the Gaitor Way Initiative to an Alumni Community Outreach and mentoring program.
