Mr. Neal Prasad and Mr. Greg Feeney were present to discuss SRA Towing status in regard to renewal of mercantile license.

High School South is not ADA compliant having no elevator, but HS East has an elevator which covers the regulations and HS South has a plan where students have class on the first floor but one parent is having an issue with the way that is working.
